
# Mission Forward: Call Committee Update



# Project Comfort Coffee - July 11/12 to benefit LWR Quilt and Shipping Fund

The Project Comfort Coffee is held each year to benefit Lutheran World Relief's Quilt and Shipping Fund. This fund is used to help defray the cost of shipping guilts and kits to people in need all around the world. Ruth Circle members will serve homemade cookies and beverages after each service the weekend of July 11/12 and accept a freewill offering for the shipping fund. All offerings collected will go directly to the LWR Quilt and Shipping Fund. The cost to LWR for shipping one guilt is \$2.25, one personal care kit costs \$2.65 and one baby care kit costs \$1.30. In 2014, Mount Olive sent 138 guilts, 50 personal care kits and 67 baby care kits to LWR: the cost of shipping Mount Olive's donations was \$530. Checks can be made out to Mount Olive WELCA with the notation "Project Comfort" on the memo line and given at the coffee or put in the offering basket during worship at any time. Your support is
