



Santa Lucia Celebration and Receptions Sunday, December 13

A Christian legend from the fourth century tells of a girl named Lucia. After her death, she was made a saint because of her strong Christian faith, charity, and love for people in need. Hundreds of years later, the legend grew following Lucia's appearance in famine stricken Sweden. St. Lucia arrived on a ship, emblazoned with light, sailing across Lake Vanern. The ship carried food for the hungry, which saved many.



Mount Olive has its roots in the Swedish Lutheran Church, and celebrates St. Lucia on the Sunday in December closest to December 13; this year it falls on the exact date. Traditionally our high school girls portray St. Lucia. The Starboys and Mint Girls are children from Kindergarten through second grade. The *Santa Lucia song* will be presented by soloist Sarah Kowalski accompanied by Brock Besse on the organ.
